**Security** - Please follow any posted traffic control signs. Special security arrangements will be enforced by Hinesburg Police. The Police Dept. has made special security arrangements for crowd and traffic control. Please give them your cooperation and every courtesy. There is an open container law in Hinesburg which will be enforced. No alcoholic beverages allowed at Town Events. Your patience is requested following the fireworks display. Hinesburg Community Police will help get traffic moving -it usually clears within 30 minutes. Also, for the safety of children, please do not throw candy from the floats. We ask that you hand out candy or goodies to fans. Thank you for your cooperation.

**Parking** - is available behind Town Hall, at Lantman's Best Market, and at H&M Auto. Handicapped parking is available at the front parking lot at HCS during the parade and at the lower parking lot for the fireworks.
